

Winnie's Christmas tree decorations.

Materials needed for this project are.

- 1) Toilet roll tube
- 2) Scissors
- 3) PVA glue
- 4) Wool/yarn (any colour) we made Christmas ones so stuck with Christmas colours
- 5) Tissue paper (or some toilet paper)
- 6) Glitter (optional)
- 7) Gems (optional)

Method

- 1) Take a cardboard toilet roll tube and cut a section measuring roughly a fingers width




- 2) Grab your wool and cut lots of lengths measuring roughly 8" or 20cm's



- 3) Take a piece of cut yarn and fold it in half, so you have a loop at one end



- 4) This looped end will be fed through the cut piece of tubing and tied on by putting the 2 loose ends through the looped end and pulling tight (not too tight but tight enough that it pulls together, you may need to see the video for this part)



- 5) Continue tying on the wool until the entire cardboard tube is covered and you have lots of loose ends dangling down see image



- 6) Hold the tube that is now covered with the wool in one hand and push all the loose ends through the tube to the other side, this will hide all the knotty bits inside the tube and create the folded piece of the beanie.

Push ends through to other side



7) Take a piece of rolled up tissue paper or a few sheets of toilet roll and roll them in a ball.



— make a Ball

8) When you have a small ball push this into the centre of the tube. This will create the dome bit of the beanie



9) Holding onto the top of the dome bit of the beanie so that the tissue doesn't push right the way through you are going to tie a piece of wool around all the dangly bit of wool to stop the tissue falling out.



10) You will see it resembles a beanie

→ Tie
Yarn around
Dome

11) Finally decorate with the glitter of gems
